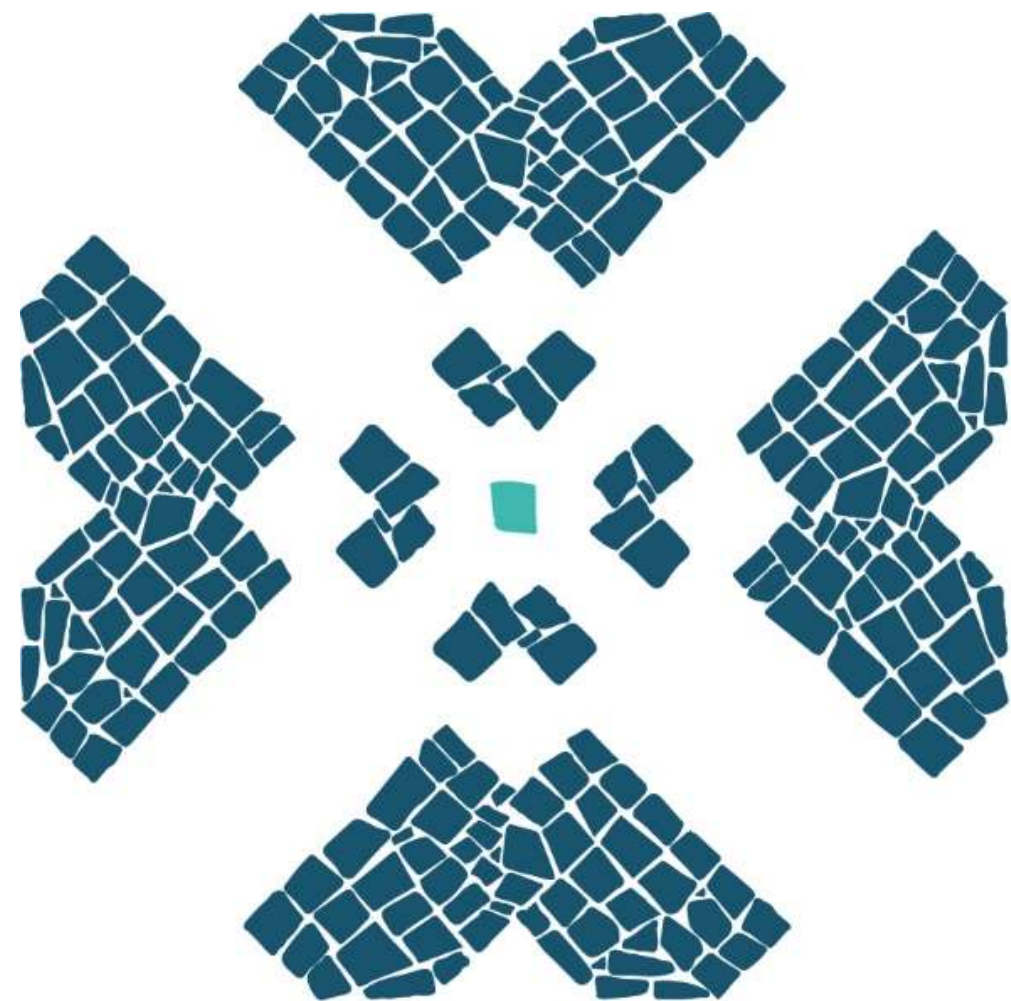

About ECIS 2017



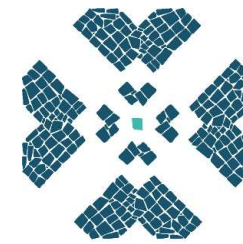
The 25th European Conference on Information Systems will take place in Guimarães at Universidade do Minho, between 8 and 10 June 2017
